

**NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 26A(3)(a) OF THE FINANCIAL INTELLIGENCE CENTRE ACT, 2001  
(ACT NO. 38 OF 2001) OF AMENDMENTS IN IDENTIFICATION OF PERSONS AND ENTITIES BY THE  
SECURITY COUNCIL OF THE UNITED NATIONS**

In terms of section 26A(3)(a) of the Financial Intelligence Centre Act, 2001 (Act No. 38 of 2001), I, **PK Smit, Acting Director** of the Financial Intelligence Centre, hereby give notice that on **19/12/2023** the Security Council of the United Nations, pursuant to United Nations Security Council Resolution **UNSCR 1267/1989-2396(2017) ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee**, amended the particulars by which it had identified **AL RASHID TRUST, QDe.005** contemplated in Notice No **TFS-01-01/04/2019** of **01/04/2019** issued under section 26A(3) of the FIC Act, as follows -
